ARCHITECTURE – OLD CORE

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy’s Architecture Program. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be a 2.0 or better. Generally, a 3.0 GPA at Mott CC is necessary for admission. We encourage you to meet with a Detroit Mercy School of Architecture administrator to discuss individual curriculum plans. ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Generally, a 3.0 GPA at Mott CC (and/or other accredited institutions) is necessary for admission. We encourage you to meet with a Detroit Mercy School of Architecture administrator to discuss individual curriculum plans.
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
